The Kingery, episode 13x03 "A BowerWorx Exclusive"

ANNOUNCER: The following Pendant production contains mature subject matter. Listener discretion is advised.

[Radio playing in the background.]

ALYSON So this is not my office, but it IS my office. Ooh, tequila.

[Alyson pouring herself a drink, sits down, sips, sets glass down.]

ALYSON

I don't know what the fuck is going on, and I just killed my parents with a fuckin Worthington, but I have a drink, and that's okay.

[A warble in reality.]

ALYSON ...okay what the fuck was THAT. Uh, where's my tequila?

[Door slams open.]

JAWBONE Auntie Aly?

ALYSON Oh for fuck's sake, DARBY?

JAWBONE Hey it's JAWBONE, Aunty Aly. No one's allowed to call me that! NO ONE. Except for ma.

ALYSON No, no, no, no. You're not here. I don't like this. Nope. I refuse. Not listening.

JAWBONE Aunty Aly, this is weird even for You.

ALYSON Stop stop stop. I really, really don't like Aunty Aly. This isn't happening, right? Am I having an Aneurysm? Do those start with hallucinations of the worst person you ever knew?

JAWBONE Who you talkin' about?

ALYSON Y'know what, for a hallucination, your intelligence level is bang-on. Did someone clone you again?

JAWBONE I don't know what yer talkin' about, so I figure you must need somethin' to do.

ALYSON Please don't strain yourself figuring.

JAWBONE An' therefore, today you're collectin' double! From everyone!

ALYSON ...I work for YOU?

JAWBONE ...uh yeah?

ALYSON You don't sound sure. JAWBONE Well I am!

ALYSON Are you?

JAWBONE I'm ... yeah ... wait what were we talkin' about?

ALYSON Christ on a cracker, this is getting realer by the minute.

JAWBONE Collectin'! DOUBLE!

ALYSON ...yes. That means I get to leave. YES.

JAWBONE And how 'bout you get the fuck outta my chair?

[Cassandra walks in.]

CASSANDRA Hello sweetie. I was just about To– what the fuck are YOU doing here?

ALYSON God, I wish I knew.

CASSANDRA Get out.

ALYSON Oh thank you so fuckin much.

[Alyson walks out.]

ALYSON

Okay, someone has to know what the fuck is going on here, right?

GEPPI

And as you can see, zis chocolate has the highest butterfat content! It will make a difference in your bakery, I assure you! Au revoir, please come again!

[A customer leaves as Alyson comes in.]

ALYSON Oh my god, Geppi!

GEPPI Ah! Ms Arkell! I did not see you zhere.

ALYSON You're okay! I mean, here. Or in my mind. Somewhere. Are you okay?

GEPPI

Zhat is not a question I am used to hearing from you, to be sure. But yes, I am well.

ALYSON That's good, that's great.

GEPPI

I expect you are here to collect for Mr. Jawbone. And what is today's request?

ALYSON

Today's? Oh, hang on, I collect something for him that's different every DAY? GEPPI That is the way he does business, yes.

ALYSON

Wow. That's like toddler level. I guess I thought he was a little smarter than that. At some point, he might have been. Maybe? God I haven't thought about him in YEARS. And I LIKED IT.

GEPPI Are you feeling all right?

ALYSON I'm not sure. I'm not sure of anything right now.

GEPPI Ah. Well. Today is a bit busy. Would you please let me know today's payment request?

ALYSON Yeah, sure, but he wasn't very specific. He just said to collect double.

GEPPI Of course he did.

[Geppi packaging up chocolates.]

ALYSON ...hang on, you pay "Mr. Jawbone" in CANDY?

GEPPI Zis ees our current arrangement, no?

ALYSON

No? I mean yes. Yes?

GEPPI Alyson, I must say that as your friend, it pains me to see you demean yourself in this line of work.

ALYSON

And I am becoming more alarmed that I'm having a breakdown, but please, go on.

GEPPI

Everyone is well aware of how Mr. Jawbone and Cassandra are quite zee ... what is the word ... laughing-stock.

ALYSON OH! Huh, I thought it was just me who felt that way.

GEPPI

(laughs) Oh, you are such a joker! Zhere is no protection, not really, and no respect for my work. Not for anyone's work, really. Not since the arrangement.

ALYSON What arrangement?

GEPPI

The arrangement where all of zee most expensive adult care facilities bring all of their residents to the Kingery for their enrichment.

ALYSON Enrichment ... of, like, old people?

GEPPI Indeed, the elderly are our main customers. It is why I have a popular low salt and low sugar candy selection. And all of my customers get free pencils. Pencils are surprisingly popular.

ALYSON

So then why the hell would you need protection? I hardly think a bunch of old people are coming in here and whacking your kneecaps.

GEPPI That did happen last week.

ALYSON Wow, really? Okay then.

GEPPI But as I was not seriously injured, I can see your point.

ALYSON Still though, why do you pay? It can't be worth it.

GEPPI

Because Mr. Jawbone does not know. It is valuable, you see, to know something that your employer does not. I sell fine chocolates here. But I take my fine chocolate boxes and I replace the candy within with the lowest quality of chocolates that I can find. It is not fit to be sold here, therefore I do not sell it.

[The wrapping is finished.]

GEPPI I will have this sent to his office immediately.

ALYSON Won't he be able to tell?

GEPPI They are his favorite. And why would I tell him otherwise? That would not be ... respectful.

[Footsteps in.]

CASSANDRA Oh my god, you decided to do your JOB today?

ALYSON Uh maybe?

GEPPI Ms Cassandra, it is excellent to see you today! You are ravishing!

CASSANDRA Can it, chocolate nerd, my sweet boy is looking for his payment.

GEPPI Your timing is impeccable! I was just packaging up his order!

CASSANDRA It's DOUBLE today!

GEPPI Yes, yes, Ms Alyson has already informed me of this! I have it right here.

CASSANDRA

Good. And hey, sister, you better get going on the rest of the rounds, if you're actually doing them. You're late.

ALYSON Uh, yep. Rest of the rounds. Sure will.

CASSANDRA ...That means NOW.

ALYSON I'm going. I just ... have a headache.

CASSANDRA ...and?

ALYSON And ... I need to get something for it.

CASSANDRA So why are you standing here jabbering like I should care? Go see Doc Briggs and hurry up!

ALYSON Oh hey yeah, she can tell me if I'm dying!

[Alyson hands the chocolate to Cassandra.]

ALYSON Here's the candy, and I desperately hope I don't see you soon.

[Footsteps away.]

CASSANDRA What is up with her today? JAWBONE HEY MA!

CASSANDRA Coming, sweetie!

[Alyson enters.]

ALYSON Hey, doc?

DOC BRIGGS But it couldn't be ... and a hormonal imbalance test would take hours to run, and a general test is showing nothing...

[Footsteps up to Doc Briggs.]

ALYSON Doc?

DOC BRIGGS (startled) Alyson, you scared me half to death.

ALYSON I am also scared half to death so we're even.

DOC BRIGGS Are you all right? What's going on?

ALYSON I feel terrible, my head hurts, and nothing makes sense.

DOC BRIGGS Okay ... pupils look even... Did you hit your head? ALYSON Not that I can remember.

DOC BRIGGS What did you have for breakfast.

ALYSON Tequila?

DOC BRIGGS That's not breakfast.

ALYSON It's the last thing I remember having, cut me some slack! Maybe I'm dying.

DOC BRIGGS I don't think you're dying.

ALYSON But how do you KNOW?

DOC BRIGGS You may not know this, but a lot of times when someone is dying, they feel pretty certain that they're dying.

ALYSON So because I DOUBT that I'm dying, I'm probably not dying?

DOC BRIGGS Honestly, yeah. Let me do a scan on you.

[A medical scanner activates.]

DOC BRIGGS I don't see any evidence of brain trauma and you don't think you hit your head, so I don't think there's anything physically wrong.

ALYSON

So would anything else show up on the scan? Like a complete mental break from reality?

DOC BRIGGS

You seem pretty lucid to me. But that being said, you're not the only one that's noticed things don't seem to be ... quite right around here.

ALYSON

So are you also seeing a bunch of people who were already dead, but now they're not dead, and maybe you murdered your mom, who was also dead before, so how can it be murder?

DOC BRIGGSmaybe you should start over.

ALYSON

My mother was somehow alive again, and I killed her, and I wasn't the boss, she was... and then things changed, and now I'm also not the boss, and my nephew is back from the dead, and also Geppi is back from the dead...

DOC BRIGGS

I don't think I've seen anyone dead, but Cass and Kaylock were not behaving like themselves, and then they were gone, and now Cass is completely different and her son is running the place, who I've never seen before in my life. ALYSON Wait, you have a bracelet?

DOC BRIGGS What? Oh, yes, Asa gave it to me.

ALYSON

I have one too. I got it as a wedding gift but I don't know who sent it. And it matches yours. What the hell is that about?

DOC BRIGGS

I don't know what the bracelet means, but I think we need to find Asa, since he gave it to me.

ALYSON

I mean, sure, at least it's a start. As long as I don't have to talk to my sister or my nephew again, maybe we'll be okay.

DOC BRIGGS

We need to get out of here before someone else comes in expecting something. I'm not really good at acting. And It'll be easier for us to cover for each other if we're together.

ALYSON

I guess, but I think I'm just some kind of lackey here.

DOC BRIGGS You're still related to the boss, right?

ALYSON Allegedly and unfortunately. DOC BRIGGS Perfect. Let's go.

ALYSON But I have no idea what I'm going to SAY if someone asks me what we're doing.

DOC BRIGGS Say you're not feeling well. That you hit your head while hanging a clock.

ALYSON I don't think anyone's gonna buy that.

ASA Y'know I didn't think this would be super easy but...

BERNICE But you didn't expect it to be so hard, I gather.

ASA Well, yeah.

BERNICE It's all science! Isn't it exciting, though!

ASA You think this is exciting? These are my friends!

BERNICE Of course, but it's intoxicating regardless. You simply don't know what might happen next! That's wonderful! ASA I feel like "wonderful" might be pushin' it to be honest.

[A warble in reality.]

ASA Oh no. It's happening again, isn't it?

BERNICE Keep your voice down, we may be perceived! Come here, behind the counter!

[Tythia, Pallas, and He-B's voices are muffled and warbly.]

TYTHIA Pallas I just ... I don't even know where to start. I've got like four backups for He-B, but none of them are recent and none of them are complete.

PALLAS You're usually so organized, so I'm kind of surprised this is the situation?

TYTHIA That's because ... I gave He-B a choice.

PALLAS A choice? You mean, like when to back him up?

TYTHIA Yeah. And unfortunately he's a lot like organics who hate to get regular checkups and so he kept putting it off and putting it off...

PALLAS So how old is the most complete backup?

TYTHIA ...two years.

PALLAS Two YEARS??

TYTHIA I know, okay! I'm frustrated too! And the worst part is I'm gonna use it!

PALLAS Well, okay, but what about the other backups you have?

TYTHIA

They're all just partial. But if I overlay them on the older backup, then maybe we'll get something approximating the old He-B. But there's no way to know until we do it.

PALLAS All right, let's get started.

BERNICE

(whispering) You see, Asa, this is like what we are doing right now! We can see and move small pieces around, but we're not sure of their effect on the whole, because the whole is constantly changing! It makes things delightfully unpredictable!

[Computery beeps as He-B powers up.]

HE-B Hello.

TYTHIA Hi He-B? Do you remember me?

ASA

(whispered) But they're still trying, isn't that the point! I've got to try, don't I?

HE-B Hello, Tythia? Why would I not remember you? What has happened?

PALLAS Kind of a long story, buddy. Can you take a minute and let us know what's the last thing you remember?

TYTHIA Hey wait, did you hear something?

BERNICE Shh!

ASA I'm shushing!

PALLAS Huh? Oh, I thought it was just someone out in the hall.

TYTHIA It kinda sounded like Asa didn't it?

[A warble in reality.]

BERNICE It's over, we can come out now.

ASA

I'm not giving up, Bernice, and you can't make me!

BERNICE

Asa, I didn't say you should give up and I'm not going to make you do anything! But you need to continue considering the various factors that we're dealing with.

ASA

And I'm considerin'! It's gotta work! It's just maybe gonna take longer than we thought, is all.

BERNICE We can keep trying, and we will. There are many more iterations to test. It's lovely, really.

ASA It's not lovely it's stressful!

BERNICE But also lovely.

ASA To you, maybe.

BERNICE Just think of all the wonderful possibilities!

ASA I am! And so far they ain't wonderful in the slightest.

BERNICE But that's how science works. Once lovely step forward, two less lovely steps back. ASA It would be nice to see ANY steps forward.

BERNICE You're probably hungry. We should take a break. Oh, I know! Would you like a lollipop?

ASA A lollipop?

BERNICE They're a BowerWorx exclusive! I made them myself.

ASA Then I definitely do not.

[Kingery theme plays.]
